

### **Ephesians 1:17-19**

God, the glorious Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, give me spiritual wisdom and insight so that I may grow in my knowledge of God. I pray that my heart will be flooded with light so that I can understand the confident hope Jesus has given to those he called—his holy people who are his rich and glorious inheritance.

### **Ephesians 3:16-19**

I pray that from his glorious, unlimited resources he will empower me with inner strength through his Spirit. Then Christ will make his home in my heart as I trust in him. My roots will grow down into God's love and keep me strong. And may I have the power to understand, as all God's people should, how wide, how long, how high, and how deep his love is. <sup>19</sup> May I experience the love of Christ, though it is too great to understand fully. Then I will be made complete with all the fullness of life and power that comes from God.

### **Philippians 1:9-11**

Jesus, help my love to overflow more and more, and that I will keep on growing in knowledge and understanding. Jesus, you want me to understand what really matters, so that I may live a pure and blameless life until the day of Christ's return. May I always be filled with the fruit of your salvation—the righteous character produced in my life by Jesus Christ—for this will bring much glory and praise to God.

### **Colossians 1:9-14**

### **Romans 15:5-7**

May God, who gives this patience and encouragement, help me live in complete harmony with one other, as is fitting for followers of Christ Jesus. Then may I join together with others in one voice, giving praise and glory to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Help me to accept other people just as Christ has accepted me so that God will be given glory.

### **Romans 15:13**

### **Romans 10:1**

### **1 Corinthians 1:4-8**

## **2 Thessalonians 1:11-12**

God, enable me to live a life worthy of Your call. May he give me the power to accomplish all the good things my faith prompts me to do. Then the name of our Lord Jesus will be honored because of the way I live, and I will be honored along with him. This is all made possible because of the grace of our God and Lord, Jesus Christ.

## **2 Thessalonians 3:1-5**
